| SUBJECT: | HHS Expands Relief Fund Eligibility and Updates Reporting Requirements |

The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS), through the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) announced the latest Provider Relief Fund (PRF) application has been expanded to include provider applications such as residential facilities, chiropractors, and eye and vision providers that have not yet received PRF distributions.

For a detailed description of all eligible Phase 3 General Distribution provider types, visit the <u>PRF website</u>. These providers and all Phase 3 applicants will have until 11:59 p.m. **EST on November 6, 2020 to submit their applications for payment consideration.**

HHS is also amending the reporting instructions to increase flexibility around how providers can apply PRF money toward lost revenues attributable to coronavirus. After reimbursing healthcare related expenses attributable to coronavirus that were unreimbursed by other sources, providers may use remaining PRF funds to cover any lost revenue, measured as a negative change in year-over-year actual revenue from patient care related sources.
