### Earned Mistrust

Present and past historical events of racism, discrimination, and injustice contribute to the earned mistrust many have regarding COVID-19. It is also important to note African American Scientists, Researchers, & Medical Doctors helped develop the COVID-19 vaccines and African American community members participated in the study trials.



### COVID-19 Information Sharing

- Do not mix rumors & myths with factual information
- If you are looking at COVID-19 information from social media (Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, etc.) only visit sites that fact-check and verify their information
- Share information from trusted sources such as the Centers for Disease Control & Prevention, the World Health Organization, & the Louisiana Department of Health
